Apply for exemption by December 31, 2022

Your Trustmark insurance protection qualifies you to apply for exemption from the new Washington state payroll tax for the <u>WA Cares Fund Program</u>. With your Trustmark coverage, you'll still have protection against long-term care costs.

The deadline to apply for your tax exemption is coming soon – Dec. 31, 2022 is the final day to submit your application.

Here are a few things to know:

- Trustmark has you covered. Once you have a policy, your rate won't
 increase due to age. You can also keep your coverage for life, even if you
 change jobs, retire or move out of state.
- Trustmark will provide you with proof of coverage, including an annual statement. You may at some points be asked for proof of your coverage.
 Access policy information via the <u>Trustmark Voluntary Benefits Portal</u>.
- The tax goes into effect on July 1, 2023. You have until December 31, 2022, to apply for exemption.
